Workshop and Activity Descriptions

446 Overriding Access Denied: New ex-offender reentry model that provides job marketing strategies, offers helps with transferring street skills to marketable work skills, navigating community resources, how to file and advocate against discrimination of ex-offenders with EEOC and HUD.

Workplace Excellence Workshop Series: This series consists of 10 modules designed to help people understand and deliver what employers really want in today's workplace.

Adaptability: Today's workplace is changing faster than ever. Learn how to navigate success in this new environment.
