HBCU Scholarship Application Information

Instructions:

1. Read the entire application before completing the application. Use blank paper to compose answers so that you can transfer them onto the application form in an orderly fashion. Please type on the application form.
2. Attach a headshot photo of yourself to the application in the space provided or upload electronically with your application submission. This photo should be conservative. By signing this application, you release the PROC Foundation, Incorporated and Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® Pi Rho Omega Chapter to use your photograph and biographical information for possible articles in the media.
3. Request a Letter of Recommendation from a total of three (3) adults (non-relatives) who know your academic ability, special talent(s) and character. Two (2) letters of recommendation must be written by school officials (such as your major advisor, professor, etc.) on school letterhead. One (1) letter of recommendation must be written by a community leader, minister, or supervisor from your employer. Please ensure the writer signs the letter. The Letters of Recommendation should be addressed to PROC Foundation, Inc., HBCU Scholarship Committee P.O. Box 6322, Richmond, VA 23230-0322.
4. Provide the following documents with your Scholarship Application Package:
 - a. Completed HBCU Scholarship Application with conservative headshot photograph attached/uploaded.
 - b. Typed double-spaced essay with no less than 300 words using the topic: **Why Attending an HBCU is Important to Me.**
 - c. An official sealed copy of your transcript dated no earlier than August 31, 2020 must be mailed or, email an electronic pdf format transcript digitally signed and certified by the college/university no later than 11:59pm (EST) on October 15, 2020.
 - d. Three (3) Letters of Recommendation from adult non-relatives: Two (2) letters from school personnel and one (1) from a community leader, minister, or a work supervisor.
5. Your complete Scholarship Application Package must be postmarked by October 15, 2020, or if electronically submitted, by 11:59 pm (EST) on this date. Application Packages postmarked or electronically submitted after this date/time or with incomplete information will not be considered. All documents, as stated in Instruction #4 above, must be received together as a complete Scholarship Application Package.

Criteria and Additional Information for Scholarship Applicant:

1. The HBCU Scholarship is open to male and female full-time students who are sophomores or juniors with a 2.8 or higher overall grade point average and is currently attending a Historically Black College or University (HBCU).
2. Applicants must provide a list of school and community service activities and leadership roles. A form is included for your convenience.
3. The application form must be fully completed and submitted with a conservative headshot photograph mailed with packet or submitted electronically, an essay, an official sealed transcript or electronic digital transcript dated no earlier than August 31, 2020 and three (3) Letters of Recommendation as outlined in Instruction #4.
4. The HBCU Scholarship Committee will screen completed application packages and select finalists. All applicants will receive a written notification of their status in the selection process.
5. The 2020 Scholarship Recipient(s) will be invited to attend a Saturday morning meeting of Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated® Pi Rho Omega Chapter for the Scholarship Presentation.
6. The selected recipient(s) will receive a one-time undergraduate scholarship valued at a minimum \$1,000 payable to the HBCU and the student. The selected recipient(s) must provide the HBCU college/university ID information.
7. The HBCU Scholarship may be forfeited if the recipient is not a full-time enrolled student for Fall 2020 at a 4-year HBCU (community colleges cannot be substituted). Proof of full-time enrollment is required prior to payment of the scholarship funds.






