

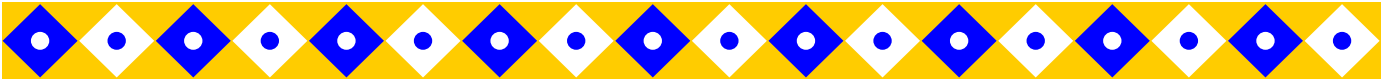

High School/College Guidelines

- Applicant must be a member of Second Baptist Church.
- Applicant must have completed course of study to obtain a diploma or GED.
- High School students must participate in at least one Youth/Church organization. College students must make a service contribution to a church or community.
- Applicant must submit an application by the 4th Sunday in May in order to get scholarship for fall semester. Scholarships are not granted to applicants who do not turn in applications on time. Application from students who are beginning their studies for the first time in the Spring or second semester must be received by the 2nd Sunday in November.
- Upon completion and approval of an application, scholarships are granted as follows: A) High School Graduates are given a one-time scholarship to attend college; B) College Graduates are given a one-time scholarship to attend graduate school.
- Confirmation of enrollment along with forwarding address must be submitted by the student no later than 1st Sunday in September.
- Scholarships will be granted in two increments as determined by the Higher Education Ministry: A) First installment will be issued in early October; B) Proof of community service is required to receive 2nd semester scholarship; C) Students who are returning to college for the second semester must notify the Higher Education Ministry prior to being awarded funds. Those not returning will not receive funds.
- If the applicant does not attend an institution of higher education, scholarship is forfeited and money returned to the church. If applicant changes from four-year to a two-year college within the first semester, funds are forfeited and money returned to the church.
- The amount of scholarships awarded depends on the number of applicants and the availability of funds.
