

Hebrew 11:1-7 (NIV)

LEADER: Now faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see.

RESPONSE: This is what the ancients were commended for.

LEADER: By faith we understand that the universe was formed at God's command, so that what is seen was not made out of what was visible.

RESPONSE: By faith Abel brought God a better offering than Cain did. By faith he was commended as righteous, when God spoke well of his offerings. And by faith Abel still speaks, even though he is dead.

LEADER: By faith Enoch was taken from this life, so that he did not experience death: "He could not be found, because God had taken him away." For before he was taken, he was commended as one who pleased God.
